Academics

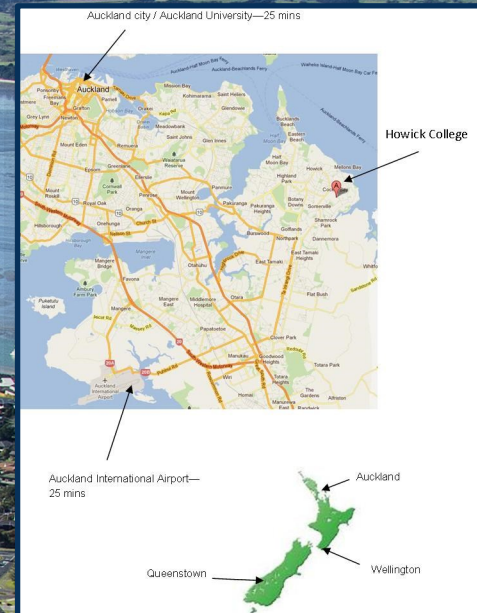
Howick College is a co-educational school for students in Year 9-13. We pride ourselves on delivering high-quality education that prepares students for future success.

Students will study the National Certificate of Educational Achievement (NCEA) curriculum, New Zealand's national qualification for secondary schools. There are three NCEA Levels: 1, 2 and 3. NCEA is the main school-leaving qualification in New Zealand and is recognised internationally.



Our highly regarded Outdoor Education programme (OED) offers students an exceptional opportunity to engage in a diverse range of outdoor activities, trips and overnight camps which can include high ropes courses, tramping and hiking, river canoeing and sailing. Through these exciting activities, students will develop leadership, self-esteem, creativity and team-building skills while experiencing the amazing landscapes and natural beauty of our country.

Outdoor Education



Location

Howick College is located in the eastern suburb of Howick, just a 30-minute drive, bus ride or ferry trip from Auckland City. As New Zealand's largest and most diverse city, Auckland provides easy access to beautiful beaches, regional parks and hiking trails.

Howick offers a safe and relaxed lifestyle for families, with its local beaches, nature reserves and parks. The area also features a range of sports, leisure, and cultural clubs as well as a charming village with boutique shops and cafés nearby.

Students may choose to live with one of the following:

- A school-approved homestay
- A parent or legal guardian
- A designated caregiver who is a relative or close family member

Students living with a homestay family will have the opportunity to experience New Zealand's customs, culture and lifestyle. All of our homestay families are carefully selected through a stringent safety process. Students who choose to stay with a host family will be placed with a warm and caring family by our experienced and dedicated Homestay Coordinator. Your homestay caregivers will welcome you as part of their family.

Students will be provided with:

- Their own bedroom
- Shared bathroom facilities
- A comfortable bed, clean bedding, a desk for studying and a wardrobe to store their personal belongings
- Three meals a day (breakfast, lunch, and a home-cooked dinner)

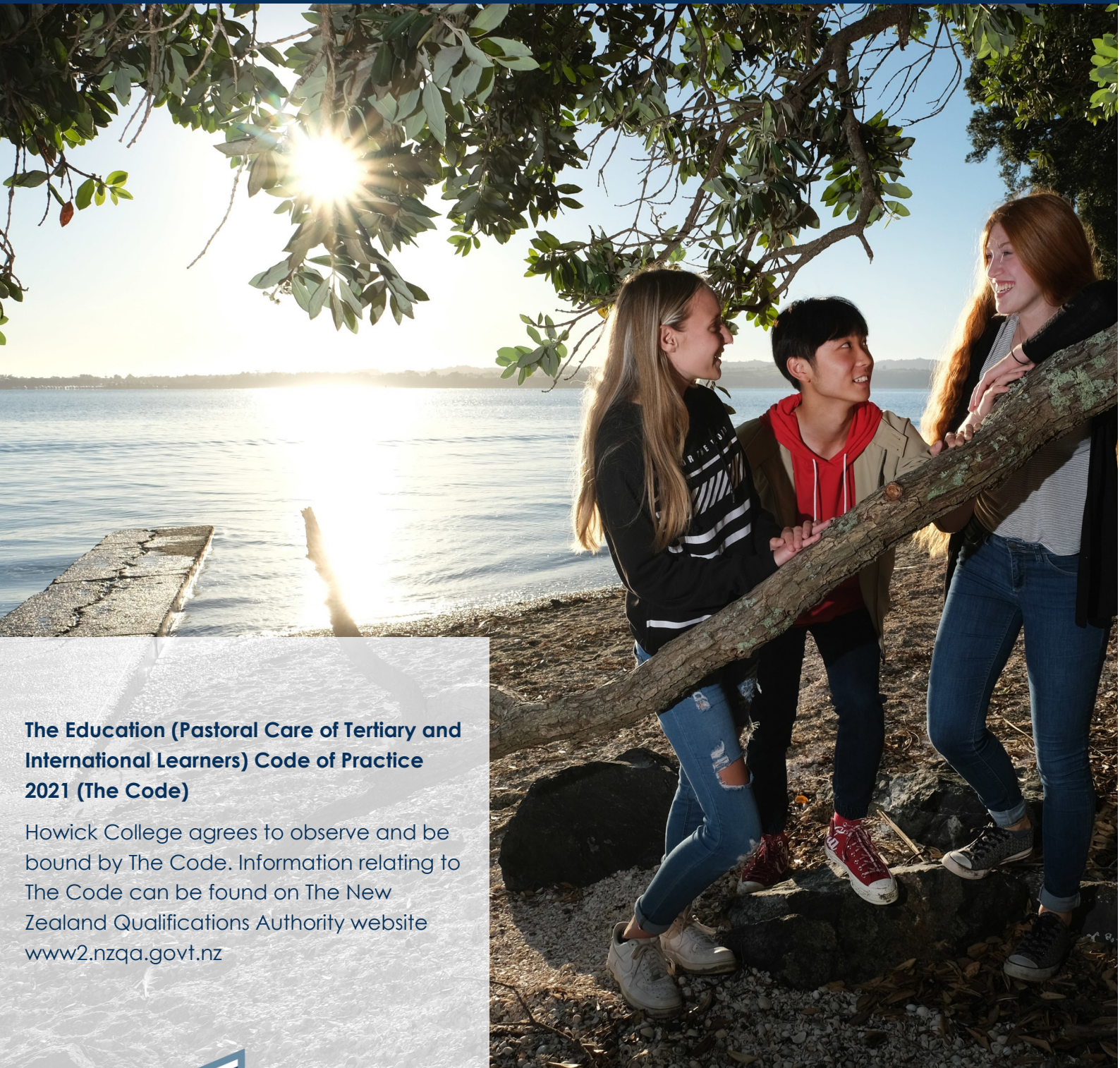
