
The deadline for registration is Thursday 16 February

WHAT IS UNDERWATER HOCKEY?

UWH is a game played at the bottom of a swimming pool, usually at a depth of 2 metres Players use a mask, snorkel, fins and a shaped stick to push a weighted puck into a goal (a trough on the bottom of the pool). There are six players in the water and up to four subs waiting poolside to sub in .
