1. The Administration and Residential Caregiver Support Fee is non-refundable and payable on enrolment/re-enrolment.
2. Homestay Fees must be paid in advance to Howick College.
3. The Homestay weekly fee may change subject to any cost-of-living increases.
4. Further fees for a change of residential caregiver occur.
5. Medical and Travel Insurance is compulsory for the duration of the student's course. It can be arranged through the school with [Uni-Care](#). The premium is calculated on exact travel dates and may differ from these estimates. Insurance fees are subject to change by the insurance provider.
6. Airfares, visa application fees, daily transport, and other living and entertainment costs are NOT included.
